



U-PASS Special Circumstance Opt-Out Form

In most cases, all part and full-time undergraduate students on the Prince George campus who are members of the Northern Undergraduate Student Society (NUGSS) are assessed the mandatory U-Pass fee. Only students who meet the following criteria will be able to receive a special circumstances UPASS Opt-out.

- a. Students with disabilities who can demonstrate a necessity to commute to and from UNBC by automobile other than on Prince George Transit fixed route or by way of HandyDART services;
- b. Students in receipt of an annual BC Bus Pass, issued by the BC Government under the BC Bus Pass Program (attach a photocopy of BC Bus Pass, both sides);
- c. Students participating in a UNBC co-op work term, practicum, or internship that takes place outside the City limits of Prince George.

This form must be submitted by the end of the first month of each semester.

This form cannot be processed until all supporting documents have been provided.
